- **WHO:** Healthcare professionals, parents, and teachers
- **WHY:** When the SSE provides 24 Hour Positioning training, it will increase the capacity of healthcare workers to develop problem-solving skills to meet the changing needs of a child with a mobility impairment within the families' specific context. Through appropriate positioning and increased capacity, clients and parents will benefit from reducing secondary health complications. This, in turn, will increase the quality of life of both the clients and their families and reduce cost of care and in the process, build local capacity.
- **WHAT:** Healthcare professionals, parents, carers, and teachers will gain the required knowledge to plan and manage daily routines which maintain good positioning. This, in turn, will encourage independence, participation and inclusion of the child; and prevent secondary complications. Further to this, it aims to develop problem-solving skills to meet the changing needs of a child with a mobility impairment within the families' specific context. The contents draws on the National Rehabilitation Policy and WHO steps for appropriate wheelchair service provision.
